Establish a beaver bounty in Clay County Drainage Districts

WHEREAS, the beaver bounty rate in drainage districts is discretionary with the Board of Supervisors, acting as Trustees for all drainage districts in Clay County, Iowa, and

WHEREAS, to facilitate the handling of repairs caused by beavers and the dams that they create in drainage within Clay County,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that effective this 25th day of February 2020, and thereafter the Auditor is hereby directed to issue warrants in the amount of \$50 per beaver for any and all claims of beavers trapped in the drainage districts and approved by the Landowner and the Drainage Trustees of that district.
