HOMESTEAD TAX CREDIT APPLICATION**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Code of Iowa, Chapters 425 and 426A the Board of Supervisors is empowered to establish by resolution that any person may request, in writing, from the Clay County Assessor, forms for the filing of Homestead Tax Credit and/or Military Service Tax Exemption; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the residents of Clay County to be allowed to make such written requests, through regular mail or electronic mailing; and,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Clay County Board of Supervisors as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Code of Iowa, Chapters 425 and 426A any person may request, in writing, from the Clay County Assessor, forms for the filing of Homestead Tax Credit and/or Military Service Tax Exemption.

Section 2. That the forms may be made available by the assessor's office and may also be accessed online through the Clay County website.
