RESOLUTION TO APPOINT A COUNTY ATTORNEY EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 27, 2020

WHEREAS, Clay County Attorney Kristi Busse resigned the Office of Clay County Attorney on October 20, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Clay County Board of Supervisors have chosen to appoint a County Attorney in accordance with Code of Iowa Sections 69.8 and 69.14A(2); and

WHEREAS, the Clay County Board of Supervisors have caused a publication announcing its intent to appoint a County Attorney and said public notice was published in an official Clay County newspaper of general circulation per Code of Iowa Sections 69.14A(2) and 331.305; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Clay County, Iowa that Travis Johnson, be appointed to and duly sworn in as the Clay County Attorney starting October 27, 2020, until after the canvass of votes for either a petitioned Special Election to fill the vacancy or when the seat appears on the November 8, 2022 General Election; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Clay County, Iowa that the County Auditor be and is hereby authorized to issue monthly paychecks on the General Fund, Office of County Attorney to Travis Johnson as Clay County Attorney at the rate previously approved by the Board of Supervisors for said elected position starting on October 27, 2020.
