

There are 3 ways to vote in this election:

1. Vote at Home

Simply complete, sign, download and mail the Absentee Request Form from this website to our office, **Clay County Administration Building, Auditor's Office, 300 West 4th Street, Spencer, IA 51301.**

You may also return your Absentee Request Form by placing it in one of the drop boxes on the north or south entrances of the Administration Building or by visiting our office. Completed Absentee Request Forms must be received in our office before 5:00 p.m. on October 24, 2020. Upon completion, we will send you a ballot in the mail which you can complete in the comfort of your home and return postage paid. Ballots returned by mail and postmarked by November 2, 2020 are counted on Election Day.

2. Vote Early in Person

You may cast your ballot early in person beginning October 5, 2020 by coming to the Clay County Auditor's Office in the Administration Building located at 300 West 4th Street, Spencer, IA. Our office hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. We are also open on October 24, 2020 and October 31, 2020 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Ballots voted early in person are counted on Election Day.

If you choose to vote on early in person, Iowa law requires you to provide an approved form of identification before voting.

3. Vote at your Precinct on Election Day, November 3, 2020 from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

If you choose to vote on Election Day, Iowa law requires you to provide an approved form of identification or have a registered voter from your precinct who has produced approved identification attest for you. You may also register to vote on Election Day at your precinct.
